## 2024 – YEAR 9 STATIONERY REQUIREMENTS

### GENERAL SCHOOL/STATIONERY REQUIREMENTS

- 1 A4 48 page exercise book (for Languages)
- 2 A4 Document wallet cardboard (for Health Education and Languages)
- 1 Safety glasses (compulsory for all Design & Technology subjects)

- 128 Gigabyte hard drive storage / 256 Gigabyte solid state drive (Min/Recommended)
- 4 Gigabyte RAM / 8 Gigabyte RAM (Min/Recommended)
- Intel i3 CPU or Equivalent / Intel i5 CPU or Equivalent (Min/Recommended)
- 5+ hour battery life (Recommended)
- 2-in-1 devices must come to school with a physical keyboard
- Windows 10/11S devices must be switched out of S-mode

- Must support Mac OS 12.0

### Additional Recommendations and information

Students should bring devices to school in a suitable case. These cases will benefit from having a hard outer shell and padded interior that fits inside a backpack to offer the best protection. Additionally, students must bring suitable earbuds that can be used with their device. All devices should be charged the night before at home to be ready for the following school day.
